



Call for Photography Exhibition Proposals

IFP Minnesota as part of its mission to provide exposure for the work of emerging and mid-career media artists seeks proposals for exhibition of photographs in the IFP Photo Gallery for 2009. Exhibitions can be solo, complementary or otherwise related two person projects, or thematic group projects. The curator may select a thematic group project from the submitted work. See guidelines for submissions requirements.

Guidelines

Specifications and Dates

The photo gallery has 115 linear feet of 11.5 foot high walls. They are made of white drywall and exposed brick with hanging chains. Exhibitions are two months in length with an artist(s) reception on or soon after the opening date.

Selected exhibitors will be required to both deliver and pick up their work on the dates set up with the curator. The work should arrive framed and ready for hanging.

Submissions

Images

Submit 12 to 20 images in digital files on a CD saved as high quality JPEGs, 96 dpi and no more than 10 inches (1000 dpi) on their longest side. Identify each image numbered in sequence that should correspond with the required images list, your name and .jpg suffix.

Example: 4. johnson.jpg

CD must be named with the artists and/or project name. The CD should be physically labeled with the artist's name(s).

Information

Submit in printed form a resume or CV (2 pages max) of each of the submitting photographers, a proposal statement (no more than one page) and image list. Please list each image as follows: number, title, date, image and frame size and printing process.

Example: 4. *Acropolis*, 2006, 15 x 19 image in 20 x 24 frame, silver gelatin print.

Artist and project name should be at the top of each submitted page.

Selection process

A preliminary selection will be made through the digital submissions. Final selection of exhibiting artists will be also based on evaluation of 5 – 8 exhibitions prints (unframed). The artist will be responsible for delivery and pickup of their prints to the IFP offices.
